Biography

Trans Voices is the UK's first professional trans+ vocal collective, launched in 2022 with a Guardian documentary centering trans empowerment in the context of the choir's formation and debut project at Union Chapel, London. Trans Voices featured alongside Years & Years in Absolut's #borntomix campaign with co-founders ILĀ and Coda Nicolaeff spotlighted in a media campaign as changemakers and community trailblazers. Recently, the collective completed a series of performances at contemporary art spaces Whitechapel Gallery, Wallace Collection, and St James Gallery. Affiliated with world-leading alternative choir London Contemporary Voices, Trans Voices is a diverse collective of vocalists and musicians. The sound of this community is utterly distinctive - spanning from hypnotic meditative soundscapes to raw calls to action without sacrificing commercial edge.

"As the first professional trans+ choir in the UK, we are here to reclaim the spaces trans voices are seldom heard in. We are telling our own stories, in our own ways. After all, there are as many ways to be a singer as there are people who sing." - ILĀ

"We're developing new ways of collective singing outside the traditional gender binary by highlighting the unique qualities of trans voices." - Coda Nicolaeff
